960.10.1 **President Report.** The President provided a report on his recent attendance at an event hosted by the Minister for Sport and Recreation Mr Hugh Delahunty. The information provided at this forum was useful in reinforcing the message in relation to participation and the focus of sport in Victoria over the next several years.

960.10.2 **Administrator's Report.** The Administrator's report is attached as Annex B to these minutes.

- **Memberships.** Memberships in Victoria have now exceeded the 1,300 mark with memberships as at 25 Mar 2013 being 1,306.
- o Participation Reports. Participation reports are now being received from most clubs. A participation report was presented and forms part of Annex B to these minutes. Only five clubs are not actively supplying participation data. Board mentors were asked to follow up with their mentor clubs to help this along.
- o **AV Loans to Clubs.** All loans are being repaid.
- ATO BAS Lodgement. All BAS statements have been lodged.
- o VicSport. Archery Victoria is now a member of VicSport.
- 960.10.3 Financial Reports. A financial report was received and forms part of Annex B to these minutes.
- 960.10.4 VMA/VIP/T1000 Updates. A final report on T1000 was submitted to the Department of Sport and Recreation Victoria on 14 June 2013. It was noted by the Board that participants of the courses had paid fees to the hosting clubs/businesses for this training and that this still needed to be refunded.
