



WHAT IS IT

The Archery Victoria (AV) State Team is selected from members of Archery Victoria to represent our association and our sport both at major events and also to the community in general.

Selection to the State Team is an achievement based on high performance and should be seen as part of the pathway of progression in the sport.

Selection should be made on merit and be an achievement worth aspiring to.

Archery Victoria will select teams regardless of events in order to help promote this pathway and give this recogition to these archers.



TEAMS TO BE SELECTED

State Target Team: Adult Team for the National Target Championships State Youth Team: Youth Team for the National Youth Championships

State Indoor Team: Adult and Youth Teams for National Indoor Championships State

Field Team: Adult and Youth Field Team

State Para and VI Team: Team attending the National Para and VI Championships

These Teams will all consist of a Recurve Team, Compound Team and Barebow Team, with the Barebow Team consisting of Barebow Recurve, Barebow Compound and Longbow unless specified differently for the major event.

Details provided in the respective selection information.





WHAT YOU GET

Those making the State team will receive

- 1 x Uniform per season (calendar year)
- Entry into Representative event
- · Promotion on AV media
- A subsidy for travel and accommodation may be paid at the discretion of the AV Board.

Uniforms will vary from season to season and archers making multiple teams will be required to use that uniform across multiple events.

Extra uniform pieces can be arranged for purchase via AV.

SELECTION OBJECTIVES

- To select teams to represent Victoria at major events
- To provide a clear and transparent selection process that puts responsibility of scores onto the archer.
- To provide a pathway in development for State archers to aspire to and the move on to National teams.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

It is the Archers responsibility to:

- · Be financial members of Archery Victoria and Archery Australia
- · Be in good standing with Archery Victoria and Archery Australia
- · Abide by all rules of competition and anti-doping rules.
- Submit their own scores to the State Team Ranking website. Scores not accurate will be rejected. Scores not submitted by the closing date will not be considered.
- Seek their own opportunities to achieve scores. It is not the responsibility of Archery Victoria to run these events.

The State Team uniforms must be worn whilst shooting and at ceremonial occasions during the Championships.

TEAM CONSTRUCTION

Eight Recurve Archers
Eight Compound Archers
Four Barebow Archers

A gender mix must be maintained as per Archery Australia rules.

- A team of eight must include 3 females
- A team of seven archers must include 2 females
- A team of six must include 2 females
- A team of five must include 2 females
- A team of four must include 1 female
- Archers Must be attending the National Youth Target Championships

SELECTION PERIOD

• For 2024 only scores shot during the period 1 Jan 23 - 16 Feb 24 will be considered.

SCORES REQUIRED

The following scores must be submitted:

 Three 720 round scores shot in the selection period at QRE's or tournaments

Archers will be ranked on the combination of the highest submitted of those scores. Archers can submit as many scores as they choose. All athletes from U12 - U20 are eligible for selection.

Scores must be submitted to the State Ranking List Website detailed later in this document.

Please note that, as well as Target, both Field and Indoor events are being contested at NYAC24. Field and Indoor scores are not being used for selection, however, those on the Archery Victoria State Team will be expected to compete in these events. Opportunities to shoot both field and indoor will be provided to State Team members prior to the event. Those wishing to be considered for the State Team should also seek their own opportunities to gain skills in these events.

Whilst Archery Australia has not requested nominations for a State Barebow Team for NYAC24, Archery Victoria has elected to nominate a State Team in this division. This team will receive the same benefits as the recurve and compound teams

Here is how it works.

Step One: Setup your account.

If you have used this website before you will have an account already. Don't create a new one.





Once you have an account you will be able to add details such as Shirt Size and Pants size for uniform ordering.





Step Two: Enter Scores
In the Top Menu Select ADD SCORES.
In the next screen a pull down menu will appear called "Select Event Team"
From that Menu Select the Team you wish to submit scores for.

Once Selected the criteria for that team will appear.

Now Select the Division you wish to Submit a score for, followed by the Round.

Step Three: Enter your Scores

Event Name: A short version of the event




Event Date: Date of event in dd/mm/yyyy

Website Link to Results. Link to the full results as shown in the screenshot. NOT to your own scorecard. (easier for the checker to get all the information that way)

Hit SUBMIT.





VIEWING YOUR SCORES

In the Top Menu Select MY SCORES.
In the next screen a pull down menu will appear called "Select Event Team"
From that Menu Select the Team you wish to view scores for.

Here you will see the list of scores you have submitted and their status.

Score checking is not instant and requires a State Team official to check. Please be patient for this process.



VIEWING THE STANDINGS

Anyone, regardless of if they have an account can view the STANDINGS by clicking on the STANDINGS link in the top menu.

Thos standings will show:

The Teams

Who has submitted scores and where they stand.

Their total score

Points behind the next place

Points behind the leader.

The DETAILS button will show you what scores that archer has shot, when and where. This allows people to also see how the scores were gathered.

Ties will be broken manually by the State Team committee.
