## 0481. **Target Grand Prix System**

## 1. **Rules**

- The Target Grand Prix shall be held from January 1st to December 31st each year. 1.1.
- The tournaments shall be selected by AV Board and shall be advertised on the AV website. 1.2.
- 1.3. The Target Grand Prix shall be offered to all categories except Crossbow.
- 1.4. To be eligible an archer must participate in a minimum 3 events.
- 1.5. The winner of each division shall be the archer with the greatest combined points over the nominated tournaments. In case of a tie there shall be joint winners.
- 1.6. Only the winner(s) of each category shall be awarded the gold medal.
- 1.7. The scoring system for a Grand Prix event shall be;
  - 1<sup>st</sup> 25 points 1.7.1.
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> 18 points 1.7.2.
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> 15 points 1.7.3.
  - 4<sup>th</sup> 12 points 1.7.4.
  - 5<sup>th</sup> 10 points 1.7.5.
  - 6<sup>th</sup> 8 points 1.7.6.
  - 7<sup>th</sup> 1.7.7. 6 points
  - 8<sup>th</sup> 4 points 1.7.8.
  - 9<sup>th</sup> 2 points 1.7.9.
  - 1.7.10. 10<sup>th</sup> 1 point
- Only Financial AV Affiliated Archers may compete. 1.8.
- 1.9. Archers who change categories through the year shall have their points allocated to the category that the competition was shot in.
- All Archers in each category shall compete equally. 1.10.
- 1.11. Classifications shall be offered for the following categories. CM, CW, RM, RW.
