## 0483. Indoor Grand Prix Indoor

## 1. Rules

- 1.1. The Indoor Grand Prix shall be held from January 1st to December 31st each year consisting of five (5) "seasons".
- 1.2. The "seasons" for the Indoor Grand Prix shall be;
  - 1.2.1. February 1<sup>st</sup> to March15<sup>th</sup>
  - 1.2.2. April 1<sup>st</sup> to May 15<sup>th</sup>
  - 1.2.3. June 1<sup>st</sup> to July 15<sup>th</sup>
  - 1.2.4. August 1<sup>st</sup> to September 15<sup>th</sup>
  - 1.2.5. October 1<sup>st</sup> to November 15<sup>th</sup>
- 1.3. The Indoor Grand Prix shall be contested shooting the FITA 18m round. A total of 600 points.
- 1.4. The Indoor Grand Prix shall be offered to all categories except Crossbow.
- 1.5. The Indoor Grand Prix shall also be offered as a ratings/handicap competition.
- 1.6. To be eligible an archer must participate in a minimum 3 seasons.
- 1.7. The winner of each category shall be the archer with the greatest combined points over the seasons. In case of a tie there shall be joint winners.
- 1.8. The winner of the ratings/handicap competition shall be the archer with the greatest combined points over the seasons. In case of a tie there shall be joint winners.
- 1.9. Only the winner(s) of each category shall be awarded the gold medal.
- 1.10. Only the winner(s) of the ratings/handicap competition shall be awarded the gold medal.
- 1.11. The scoring system for a Grand Prix event shall be;
  - 1.11.1. 1<sup>st</sup> 25 points
  - 1.11.2. 2<sup>nd</sup> 18 points
  - 1.11.3. 3<sup>rd</sup> 15 points
  - 1.11.4. 4<sup>th</sup> 12 points
  - 1.11.5. 5<sup>th</sup> 10 points
  - 1.11.6. 6<sup>th</sup> 8 points
  - 1.11.7. 7<sup>th</sup> 6 points
  - 1.11.8. 8<sup>th</sup> 4 points
  - 1.11.9. 9<sup>th</sup> 2 points
  - 1.11.10. 10<sup>th</sup> 1 point

- 1.12. Only Financial AV Affiliated Archers may compete.
- 1.13. Archers who change categories through the year shall have their points allocated to the category that the competition was shot in.
- 1.14. All Archers in each category shall compete equally, without Class difference.
- 1.15. All archers shall use the AV Indoor Grand Prix scorecard. Hosting venues can download these from the AV website. /members area/documents/0667 indoor grand prix scorecard.
- 1.16. All archers will be automatically entered into the open competition and the ratings/handicapped competition.
- 1.17. Hosting venues can download the Indoor Grand Prix results sheet from the AV website. /members area/documents/0668 indoor grand prix result sheet.
- 1.18. Hosting venues shall update the spreadsheet (including the club, category, rating and the handicap) after each event. Multiple entries are expected and do not need to be sorted.
- 1.19. Hosting venues shall send the completed result sheet for the season to the AV CEO by e-mail no later than the 20th of the month that the season finishes.
- 1.20. The rating shall be provided by the archer and shall be entered on the scorecard before shooting. /members area/documents/0450 rating table indoor.
- 1.21. The handicap shall be provided by the hosting venue and shall be entered on the scorecard after shooting. The handicap table is available from the AV website. /members area/documents/0451 handicap table indoor.
- 1.22. The Indoor Grand Prix shall be conducted under the same rules as a QRE in that a Judge or an AA accepted person should be available to verify the rules, timing, range layout, scores, etc. This will allow state tournament records to be claimed.
