Introduction

The Record Claim Form is used by archers to submit a claim for a State Record. Accurate completion of this form ensures that performances are verified efficiently and that records are processed without delay.

Before submitting a claim, archers should ensure that all required information is complete and correct, including event details and a copy of the score sheet. (Score sheets may be originals, scanned, photocopied, or a legible digital photo).

Claims must be lodged within the 30 days following the event and must meet all eligibility requirements outlined by Archery Victoria and Archery Australia.

This form should be completed neatly and legibly, with all relevant sections filled in. Incomplete or inaccurate forms may result in the claim being delayed or rejected.
